GENERAL

1. Sainik Schools Society (SSS), an autonomous organisation under the Ministry of Defence, Govt of India is a registered society under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and manages Sainik Schools including approved New Sainik Schools located in various parts of the country. These schools are involved in imparting quality education and training to Cadets to be good citizens and prepare them to join the Defence Forces as well as excel in all walks of life. Admissions in the Sainik Schools and the Approved New Sainik Schools in partnership mode are governed by the Sainik Schools Society (SSS).

2. **Sainik Schools (SS)**. Sainik Schools are wholly residential English medium schools that offer a common curriculum and are affiliated with the CBSE, New Delhi. Sainik Schools prepare Cadets to join the National Defence Academy (NDA), Khadakwasla (Pune), Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala and other Training Academies as officers in addition to the All India Senior School Certificate Examination. All existing Sainik Schools cater for the Science stream subjects only. Besides academic advancement, the students are encouraged to develop their creative faculties through co-curricular activities and socially useful productive works. They are also introduced systematically to all major games and are imparted with NCC training. A list of existing Sainik Schools is given at **Appendix-A**.

3. **New Sainik Schools (NSS)**. The Ministry of Defence (MoD) had approved the scheme for setting up of approved New Sainik Schools, in partnership mode with NGOs/private schools/State Governments. These approved New Sainik Schools, besides their affiliation to respective Education Boards, function under the aegis of the Sainik Schools Society and follow the Rules and Regulations for approved New Sainik Schools prescribed by the Sainik Schools Society. In addition to their regular affiliated Board curriculum, they also impart education of Academic-PLUS curriculum to the students on the Sainik School pattern. The fee structure, Education Board and language of Instructions of approved New Sainik Schools differ from School to School. A list of approved New Sainik Schools is given at **Appendix-B**.

ADMISSIONS

4. **All India Sainik School Entrance Examination (AISSEE)**. Admission is based on the performance of candidates in the All-India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE). The admission of candidates will be carried out on the basis of e-counselling as per rank secured by the candidates in the school wise, gender wise, category wise (Home State and Outside State) Merit List of AISSEE-2026, medical fitness approved by competent medical authorities, verification of original documents and payment of school fees.

5. **Admission to Sainik School is in Class VI and Class IX only through AISSEE-2026 for the academic year 2026-27. Admission for Sainik School pattern in the approved New Sainik Schools is in Class VI and Class IX (19 NSS) through AISSEE-2026 for the academic year 2026-27.**

6. Sainik Schools Society has developed an e-counselling portal for admission into existing and New Sainik Schools named **All India Sainik School Admission Counselling (AISSAC)**. It is mandatory for the candidates to register through the official e-counselling online portal to be able to obtain seats to be allocated through AISSAC in any of the existing and New Sainik Schools. The category-wise intake capacity known as seat matrix is available on the online portal, <https://sainikschoolssociety.bisag-n.gov.in/sainikschoolcounselling/>.

7. The SOP stated herein will be followed for allocating seats for the above-referenced admissions for the academic year 2026-27, through All India Sainik Schools Admission Counselling-2026.

8. **The seat allocation process follows a strict timeline and procedure.** The entire process is online, and computer operated. **No exceptions are possible and therefore, candidates are strongly advised to thoroughly acquaint themselves with SOP, be vigilant, keep their documents handy and make arrangements for making the requisite payments, well in advance.** It will not be possible to entertain requests for an extension of time for adhering to a timeline or for completing any activity. Candidates having any queries may reach out to the Sainik Schools/SSS. The contact numbers and email ids are mentioned on the portal in the Sainik School information tab.

9. A seat to the highest possible choice of school is allocated to the candidate in e- counselling considering the following factors: -

- 9.1 Domicile of the candidate's Home State (HS) or Other State (OS) as described in AISSEE-2026 information bulletin.
- 9.2 The category [GEN, OBC-NCL, SC, ST, DEF] of the candidate.
- 9.3 All India Rank of the candidate in the respective rank list(s).
- 9.4 The order of preference of schools selected by the candidate.
- 9.5 The availability of seats in different seat categories/seat quotas for which the candidate is eligible.
- 9.6 Other rules as mentioned in this SOP.

10. National Testing Agency (NTA) conducts AISSEE and Sainik Schools Society frames the policies and norms for seat allocation to Sainik Schools. Bhaskaracharya National Institute for Space Applications and Geo-informatics (BISAG-N) extends its technical support for providing the services of e-Counselling and Admission for the above-said activities carried out by SSS.

11. No agency other than AISSAC/ SSS is responsible for seat allocation to the seats at existing and approved New Sainik Schools. **Candidates seeking information/assistance from any agency/ agent other than authorised by AISSAC/ SSS shall be doing so at their own risk and cost.** There is only one AISSAC-2026 official website, viz., <https://sainikschoolssociety.bisag-n.gov.in/sainikschoolcounselling/>.

12. **Any student who has appeared for AISSEE-2026 and has secured qualifying marks is eligible to apply for e-counselling through the AISSAC portal (Qualification criteria are explained in the AISSEE Information bulletin 2026).**

RESERVATION CRITERIA

13. Reservation criteria for existing 33 Sainik Schools.

13.1 67% of the seats are reserved for candidates domiciled in the State/ UT where the Sainik School is located. 33% of the seats are reserved for candidates from Other States and Union Territories (UT). Within each Category of Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT quota, seats will be reserved on the following lines: -

- 13.1.1 15% of the seats are reserved for the category Scheduled Caste (SC),
- 13.1.2 7.5% for the category Scheduled Tribe (ST) and
- 13.1.3 27% for the category Other Backward Classes belonging to the Non-Creamy layer (OBC-NCL) as per the central list.

13.2 Thus, 49.5% of the seats in Sainik School are reserved on the above-mentioned lines in both Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT quota. Out of the balance 50.5% of the seats in both Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT quota, 25% of the seats are reserved for wards of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy / Indian Air Force) personnel and ex- servicemen.

13.3 In "Other States/ UT" quota, seats will be allotted in each category as per merit, subject to a maximum limit of 25% of vacancies in all the categories (i.e. SC, ST, OBC-NCL, DEF & GEN) for each State or Union Territory. E.g. If there are 10 seats in Other States/UT Category, Candidates of any particular State/UT will not be granted more than 3 seats (25% of 10 or 2.5 rounded off to 3).

13.4 In Class VI of each Sainik School, 10% of the total vacancies or 10 seats, (whichever is more), are reserved for girl candidates.

14. **Reservation in approved New Sainik Schools.** There is no policy for the implementation of reservation in New Sainik Schools from SSS. The reservation in New Sainik Schools is as per decision of the School management or competent authority.

CATEGORISATION OF CANDIDATES

15. **For Sainik Schools.** The concept of Home State (HS) and Outside State (OS) is linked to the domicile of the candidate and is determined with reference to the location of the Sainik School opted by him/her during choice-filling/ prioritisation of schools, post registration on AISSAC-2026 web-portal.

16. For the purpose of seat allocation, AISSEE-2026 qualified candidates are categorised based on their domicile. On the basis of such a categorisation, each candidate is assigned a category tag as given below: -

16.1 For Home State (HS). A candidate is deemed to belong to the Home State (HS), if his State/UT of domicile and the State/UT where the Sainik School opted by him in his application is located, are the same.

16.1.1 For example, a candidate who is domiciled in the State of Gujarat has opted for Sainik School at Balachadi (Gujarat) as first option at the time e-counselling and opts Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra) as his second option, then the candidate is deemed to belong to the Home State (HS) of Gujarat for the purpose of admission to Sainik School Balachadi (Gujarat) and is deemed to belong to the Outside State (OS) for the purpose of admission to the Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra), in case, the candidate does not get seat allocation in Sainik School Balachadi.

16.1.2 Category tag GEN (HS). This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (**HOME_GEN**) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid domicile certificate to be assigned this tag.

16.1.3 Category tag OBC-NCL (HS). This is assigned to the candidate of Other Backward Classes (**HOME_OBC**) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. **The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.**

16.1.4 Category tag SC (HS). This is assigned to the candidate of Scheduled Castes (**HOME_SC**) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.**

16.1.5 Category tag ST (HS). This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (**HOME_ST**) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.**

16.1.6 Category tag DEF (HS). This is assigned to the candidate who is a ward of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (**HOME_DEF**) and considered for Home State. **Candidates must produce valid documents/certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.**

16.2 For Outside State (OS). A candidate is deemed to belong to Other State (OS), if his State/UT of domicile and the State/UT where the Sainik School opted by him in his application/e-counselling is located, are different.

16.2.1 For example, a candidate who is domiciled in the State of Gujarat has opted for the Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra) at the time of e-counselling as his first option, and opted for Sainik School Balachadi (Gujarat) as his second option, then the candidate is deemed to belong to the Outside State (OS) for the purpose of admission to Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra) and is deemed to belong to the Home State (HS) for the purpose of admission to the Sainik School Balachadi (Gujarat), in case, the candidate does not get seat allocation in Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra).

16.2.2 **Category tag GEN (OS).** This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (**OTHER_GEN**) and considered for Outside State.

16.2.3 **Category tag OBC-NCL (OS).** This is assigned to a candidate of Other Backward Classes (**OTHER_OBC**) and considered for Outside State. Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate to be assigned this tag. **The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.**

16.2.4 **Category tag SC (OS).** This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Castes (**OTHER_SC**) and considered for Outside State. Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.**

16.2.5 **Category tag ST (OS).** This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (**OTHER_ST**) and considered for Outside State. Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.**

16.2.6 **Category tag DEF (OS).** This is assigned to the candidate who are wards of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (**OTHER_DEF**) and considered for Outside State. **Candidates must produce valid documents/ certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.**

Note-

Ladakh (UT) candidates will be considered in Home State for admission in Sainik School Nagrota located in Jammu and Kashmir.

17. For New Sainik Schools - 40% route (NSS40).

17.1 At least 40% of the seats under the Sainik School stream in approved NSSs will be filled on the basis of the rank secured in the All India (AI) Merit List of AISSEE-2026. Candidates can opt for any NSS in India, at the time of e-counselling.

17.2 New Sainik Schools does not follow any uniform reservation policy with regard to allocation of seats. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category-wise, then each candidate is assigned a category tag as given below:-

17.2.1 **Category tag GEN (NSS40).** This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (**NSS40_GEN**). **For the purpose of admissions under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in General Category.**

17.2.2 **Category tag OBC-NCL (NSS40).** This is assigned to a candidate of Other Backward Classes (**NSS40_OBC**). Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate to be assigned this tag. **The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.**

17.2.3 **Category tag SC (NSS40)**. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Castes (**NSS40_SC**). Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.**

17.2.4 **Category tag ST (NSS40)**. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (**NSS40_ST**). Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.**

17.2.5 **Category tag DEF (NSS40)**. This is assigned to the candidate who is a ward of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (**NSS40_DEF**) and considered for Home State. **Candidates must produce valid documents/certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.**

18. **For New Sainik Schools - 60% route (NSS60).**

18.1 Up to 60% of the seats in NSSs will be filled by the candidates currently studying in Class VI/ VIII in any of the approved NSSs who have appeared and qualified for AISSEE-2026. They will be filled on the basis of rank secured by the candidate in the school and availability of seats filled by their respective school.

18.2 Candidates in this category are assigned a tag of **NSS60**. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category-wise, then each candidate is assigned a category tag as given below: -

18.2.1 **Category tag GEN (NSS60)**. This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (**NSS60_GEN**). **For the purpose of admissions under the NSS60 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in General Category.**

18.2.2 **Category tag OBC-NCL (NSS60)**. This is assigned to a candidate of Other Backward Classes (**NSS60_OBC**). Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate to be assigned this tag. **The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.**

18.2.3 **Category tag SC (NSS60)**. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Castes (**NSS60_SC**). Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.**

18.2.4 **Category tag ST (NSS60)**. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (**NSS60_ST**) Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. **The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.**

18.2.5 **Category tag DEF (NSS60).** This is assigned to the candidate who is a ward of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (**NSS60_DEF**) and considered for Home State. **Candidates must produce valid documents/certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.**

Explanation of 40% & 60% Route.

1. A minimum of 40% (**Category 'A'**) of the seats will be filled by drawing candidates who appear and qualify in the AISSE Examination conducted by NTA and are desirous of taking admission to the New Sainik School through the merit list of AISSEE conducted by NTA.
2. A maximum of 60% (**Category 'B'**) of the total number of seats may be filled by Students already enrolled in that School, based on a qualifying test conducted by NTA or any other appropriate testing body as prescribed by SSS to be taken by students of Class V of the same school who are willing to take admission in Sainik School Vertical.
3. In cases where the school is unable to fill its seats with **Category 'B'** students who are already enrolled in school, the vacancies will be filled by drawing candidates from **Category 'A'** students who appear and qualify in the AISSE Examination conducted by NTA and are desirous of taking admission in the New Sainik School through the merit list of AISSEE conducted by NTA.

DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS

19. **Sainik Schools.** The total intake (i.e., the number of seats) for the purpose of admission is divided into different categories. These are HOME_DEF, HOME_OBC, HOME_SC, HOME_ST, HOME_UN, OTHER_DEF, OTHER_OBC, OTHER_SC, OTHER_ST, OTHER_UN. The category tags of candidates who are eligible in different Category sections are shown in the table below: -

Note- Category tags and Gender tags will be separate for Boys and Girls both in existing Sainik Schools as the vacancies for both the gender are different.

20. **New Sainik Schools.**

20.1 NSS40% Route. In case, if any school decides to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then the total intake (i.e., the number of seats) for the purpose of admission through the NSS40 Route is divided into different categories. These are NSS40_UN, NSS40_OBC, NSS40_DEF, NSS40_SC, NSS40_ST. For the purpose of admissions under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in General Category and will be assigned the NSS40_GEN tag (except schools having reservation). The category tags of candidates who are eligible in different Category sections are shown in the table below: -

20.2 NSS60% Route. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then the total intake (i.e., the number of seats) for the purpose of admission through the NSS60 Route is divided into different categories. These are NSS60_UN, NSS60_OBC, NSS60_DEF, NSS60_SC, NSS60_ST. For the purpose of admissions under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in the General Category and will be assigned the NSS60_GEN tag (except schools having reservation). The category tags of candidates who are eligible in different Category sections are shown in the table below: -

Note- In approved New Sainik School, if seats are filled in Gender Neutral, then seat allocation to candidates will be as per merit irrespective of Gender.

21. The school-wise number of seats available in SSs and NSSs for different candidate categories/quotas, if applicable (i.e., seat matrix), will be available on the online portal <https://sainikschoolssociety.bisag-n.gov.in/sainikschoolecounselling/>.

22. **AISSAC-2026** allocates seats as per the seat matrix data provided by the participating schools. It is the sole responsibility of each participating school to provide the seat matrix data taking into consideration the reservation and other policies applicable to them / decided by them. **AISSAC-2026 / Sainik Schools Society** is NOT responsible for the seat matrix data.

RANK LIST

23. **Sainik Schools**. Seat allocation in SSs is based on AISSEE-2026 All India Rank. The following TYPES of rank lists will be used: -

23.1 **For Home State**. All candidates (boys and girls both) who belong to the Home State category as explained in this document in Para 16.1 above will be considered for allocation to the Sainik School/s located in their Home State.

23.1.1 **Home State-Unreserve rank list (HOME UN)**. In the HOME_UN category, the candidates who belong to the Home State category based on their All-India Rank and Domicile irrespective of their category (SC, ST, OBC-NCL & DEF) will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME_UN, HOME_OBC, HOME_SC and HOME_ST.

23.1.2 **Home State-OBC (NCL) rank list (HOME OBC)**. In the HOME_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates who belong to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME_OBC.

23.1.3 **Home State-SC rank list (HOME SC)**. In the HOME_SC category, the SC category candidates belonging to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME_SC.

23.1.4 **Home State-ST rank list (HOME ST)**. In the HOME_ST category, the ST category candidates belonging to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME_ST.

23.1.5 **Home State-Defence rank list (HOME DEF)**. In the HOME_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME_DEF.

23.2 **For Outside State**. All candidates belonging to the Outside State category as explained in this document in Para 16.2 above will be considered for allocation to the Sainik School/s located in Other States.

23.2.1 **Outside State-Unreserve rank list (OTHER UN)**. In the OTHER_UN category, the candidates belong to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile irrespective of their category (SC, ST & OBC-NCL) will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER_UN, OTHER_OBC, OTHER_SC and OTHER_ST.

23.2.2 **Outside State-OBC (NCL) rank list (OTHER OBC).** In the OTHER_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in the Outside state (other than located in the Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER_OBC.

23.2.3 **Outside State-SC rank list (OTHER SC).** In the OTHER_SC category, the SC category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER_SC.

23.2.4 **Outside State-ST rank list (OTHER ST).** In the OTHER_ST category, the ST category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER_ST.

23.2.5 **Outside State-Defence rank list (OTHER DEF).** In the OTHER_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in the Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER_DEF.

24. **New Sainik Schools- NSS 40% route.**

24.1 **NSS40-Unreserve rank list (NSS40 UN).** In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then in the NSS40_UN category, the candidates on their All India Rank irrespective of their category (SC, ST & OBC-NCL) will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. For the purpose of seat allotment under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates, for admission into these New Sainik Schools will be considered under the General Category (except for schools having reservation). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_UN, NSS40_OBC, NSS40_DEF, NSS40_SC, and NSS40_ST.

24.2 **NSS40-OBC (NCL) rank list (NSS OBC).** In the NSS40_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_OBC.

24.3 **NSS40-SC rank list (NSS SC).** In the NSS40_SC category, the SC category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_SC.

24.4 **NSS40-ST rank list (NSS ST).** In the NSS40_SC category, the ST category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_ST.

24.5 **NSS40-Defence rank list (NSS40 DEF).** In the NSS40_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Defence category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_DEF.

25. **New Sainik Schools -For NSS 60% Route.**

25.1 **NSS60-Unreserve rank list (NSS60 UN).** In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then in the NSS60_UN category, the candidates, based on the All India Rank secured (among existing school students) and seats filled by the school, will be considered for allocation in his/her own school. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_UN, NSS60_OBC, NSS60_DEF, NSS60_SC, and NSS60_ST.

25.2 **NSS60-OBC (NCL) rank list (NSS60 OBC).** In the NSS40_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates, based on the All India Rank secured (among existing school students) and seats filled by the school, will be considered for allocation in his/her own school. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_OBC.

25.3 **NSS60-SC rank list (NSS60 SC).** In the NSS60_SC category, the SC category candidates, based on the All India Rank secured (among existing school students) and seats filled by the school, will be considered for allocation in his/her own school. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_SC.

25.4 **NSS60-ST rank list (NSS60 ST).** In the NSS60_ST category, the ST category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_ST.

25.5 **NSS60-Defence rank list (NSS40 DEF).** In the NSS60_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Defence category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_DEF.

SEQUENCE IN WHICH SEAT CATEGORIES ARE CONSIDERED FOR SEAT ALLOCATION.

26. The sequence in which seat categories are considered for seat allocation for existing and New Sainik Schools is as follows: -

26.1 **For Sainik Schools.** Seat allotment sequence for Sainik Schools (SSs) system for Home State (HS) and Outside States (OS) seats only.

1. In approved New Sainik School, if seats are filled in Gender Neutral, then seat allocation to candidates will be as per merit irrespective of Gender.

MULTIPLE STUDENT - SAME RANK RULE

27. In the event that there are fewer number of seats available under a particular category in a school, than the number of candidates with the same category-wise rank seeking admission to the same school, then all those candidates will be offered seats by creating a requisite number of supernumerary seats after exhausting inter-se-merit of candidates as per Para 13.8 of AISSEE-2026 Information Bulletin issued by NTA.

VERIFICATION OF DETAILS & CORRECTION WINDOW

28. A correction window was provided during the registration process for AISSEE-2026 to allow candidates to amend certain details. **Candidates are advised to carefully verify their personal details while completing their registration on the AISSAC-2026 portal.** During registration on the AISSAC-2026 portal, candidates will be provided with a **one-time opportunity** to modify specific information such as domicile state, gender, and category. However, personal details including the candidate's name, father's, mother's or guardian's name, and date of birth cannot be altered during the correction window on AISSAC-2026 portal. (Refer to **Appendix 'E'**)

REGISTRATION AND FILLING-IN OF CHOICES OF SCHOOLS

29. Registration of candidates, correction of personal particulars during correction window and filling-in of choices of schools on the AISSAC portal has already concluded for which relevant public notices are placed at **'Appendix-E'**.

29.1 The flow chart to understand the process of e-counselling is attached at Appendix-C.

30. Registration and Filling-in of choices on the online portal were free of cost, i.e., candidates were NOT required to pay any fee.

31. Candidates are advised to visit the respective school website(s) for fee structure, scholarship and other related information applicable for Individual schools. AISSAC-2026 /SSS shall not be responsible for fee structure, scholarships etc related rules applicable for Individual schools and will not entertain any request or complaint regarding the Fee Structure.

Candidates are strongly discouraged from sharing their login information with others.

32. CONDUCT OF MEDICALS. Subsequent to the declaration of AISSEE-2026 results by NTA, candidates up to **three times** the number of available vacancies (class-wise, category-wise & gender-wise) in Class VI and Class IX at Sainik Schools, shortlisted strictly on the basis of the All-India Rank (AIR) secured in AISSEE-2026, were considered for appearing in medical examinations at nominated Sainik School hospitals during the prescribed timelines for conduct of medicals.

32.1 The shortlisted candidates were referred to the hospitals earmarked by the respective Sainik Schools for the conduct of medical examinations, based on the domicile registered by the candidate.

32.2 The concerned Sainik Schools updated the medical examination status of the candidates on the AISSAC-26 portal in **real-time basis**.

32.3 An approximate one-month window was allocated for conducting medicals, accommodating candidates' end-year examinations, facilitating large-scale medicals at hospitals, and reviewing unfit cases, with schools required to update medical status on the portal **within prescribed timelines**.

32.4 Medicals are being conducted at the initial stage to assess candidates' fitness and expedite the subsequent stage of the counselling process. However, this does not constitute that the school where medical has been taken has been allotted to the candidate for admission purposes.

32.5 It was imperative that the candidate shortlisted for medicals completes the prescribed medical examination at the earliest after being allotted the designated medical centre by the school and reporting to the nominated school.

32.6 A candidate who is declared medically unfit or who remains absent for the medical examination **shall not be eligible** for counselling or admission to Sainik Schools.

32.7 During the conduct of online/ offline counselling, candidates who were not shortlisted for medical examination previously shall be required to undergo medical examination at the school allotted to them. The responsibility for conducting such medical examinations shall rest with candidate to tie up with the respective schools.

32.8 Public notices issued towards conduct of medicals are placed at '**Appendix-E**'

OPTION AVAILABLE TO THE CANDIDATES AFTER SEAT ALLOTMENT

33. It is the candidate's responsibility to log in to the AISSAC-2026 portal and check if a seat is allocated in a given round of seat allocation. A schedule of e-counselling activities will be updated on the website along-with release of bulk SMS/ email to qualified candidates. If the candidate is allocated a seat, the following option will be available to the candidates, for which the candidate needs to take action (ACCEPT/ REJECT) before the last date/time specified for the given round, i.e. the round in which seat is allocated.

33.1 If no action is taken by the candidate, the seat allotted to the candidate will be cancelled and it will be considered that the candidate is not interested in the counselling process and the candidate will not be considered to participate in present round of online counselling or claim admission in any school based on AISSEE-2026 merit

33.1.1 Such candidates **may** be considered during offline rounds of counselling subject to availability of seats (except those who were offered 1st Priority of school by portal).

IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE FOR CANDIDATES OFFERED SEAT BY AISSAC PORTAL

34. **Candidates allotted 1st Preference of School.** If the candidate has been allotted his/ her **1st preference of school by portal and candidate accepts the school on portal**, then the candidate has to **mandatorily complete admission formalities** at the allotted school.

34.1 Candidates who accept the 1st preference of school on portal and complete the admission formalities at the school, would no longer be eligible for counselling in subsequent rounds of counselling for Academic Year 2026-27.

34.2 Candidates offered 1st preference of school, who reject/ do not take any action on portal in stipulated time, or do not complete the admission formalities at the school, would no longer be eligible for counselling in subsequent rounds of counselling.

35. **Candidates not allotted 1st Preference of School.** If the candidate has not been allotted his/ her **1st preference of school and candidate accepts the school**, then also the candidate has to **mandatorily complete admission formalities** at the allotted school.

35.1 Such candidates who complete their admission formalities at allotted school and school admits them on portal, would be considered for higher priority schools as per their preference automatically by the portal during subsequent rounds of online counselling, subject to inter-se-merit and availability of vacancies at school towards ensuring effective first-choice of the candidate.

35.2 Candidates may opt for higher-priority schools in subsequent rounds of online counselling by accepting the upgraded allotment on the AISSAC portal. Upon such upgradation, the fees, medical records, and other documents shall be transferred by the previously allotted school to the newly allotted higher-priority school. Failure to accept the upgraded school by candidate on portal within the stipulated time shall result in forfeiture of the claim to that higher-priority school of candidate in subsequent rounds.

35.3 It is pertinent to mention that the candidate, once opting for higher priority school in subsequent round, would not be able to retain their seat at previously allotted school, which would then be offered in turn to the next candidate in merit.

35.4 Candidates not offered 1st preference of school, who do not take any action on portal in stipulated time, or do not complete the admission formalities at the school, may be considered for offline round of counselling, only for their 1st preference school, subject to inter-se-merit of candidates.

36. **Candidates allotted school by portal.** The following option will be available to the candidates after allotment of school: -

36.1 **ACCEPT.**

36.1.1 If a candidate accepts the allotted seat, he/she has to complete admission formalities (Medical cum Physical Verification - if not done previously) within the prescribed time.

36.1.2 Failing to do so, the candidate will not be able to participate in any further round of counselling or claim admission in any School based on the merit of the AISSEE-2026 exam.

36.2 **REJECT.**

36.2.1 If a candidate is not satisfied with the seat allotted, he/she can opt for the 'REJECT' option to participate in the next round of counselling for the remaining available seats for other preferred schools minus the school allotted to him. However, in doing so, the allotted seat shall be automatically cancelled and no further claim will be admissible. The candidate will not be considered for the same School again.

36.2.2 It may further be noted that 'REJECT' does not entail change in priorities/choices for school. The Choice of schools filled prior to commencement of online rounds will be considered for all online rounds.

37. **Candidates not allotted school by portal/ waitlisted candidates.** The candidate needs to await his/her turn in merit for subsequent rounds of counselling.

38. The waiting lists for schools shall be dynamically updated by the portal in each round of counselling. During online counselling, candidates shall be able to view their status for up to three preferred schools in their result, in the following manner: -

38.1 One allotted school along with two waiting list schools; or

38.2 Three waiting list schools, where no allotment has been made.

38.3 The above schools shall be displayed based on the candidate's inter-se merit and shall be visible only if the candidate falls within the top three times the number of vacancies of the respective school.

Note-

1. On selection of either of the Accept/ Reject by the candidates, a pop-up window would appear, to re-confirm their choice of Accept/ Reject as 'Yes' or 'No' option.

2. The statement of the pop-up window selection of either of the Accept/ Reject , would be: -

Accept	Reject
1. You have selected 'Accept' option.	1. You have selected 'Reject' option.
2. Common for all options: -	
<i>"Are you sure, you want to continue?"</i>	
"Yes" - This is re-confirmation by candidate on his option selected.	
"No" - This would re-direct the candidate back to the previous screen of selecting the options of Accept/ Reject	

PROVISIONAL OFFER OF SEAT AND ITS CONFIRMATION

39. The allocation of slots for medical and reporting for physical verification of the documents will be intimated to the candidates by the allotted school through email on registered email id and SMS on mobile, if the candidate was not shortlisted earlier for medicals.

39.1 In case candidate has received email/SMS for admission to allotted school and there is no intimation from the allotted school, the candidate is to contact the school authorities.

40. A candidate who has been allocated and **ACCEPTED** a seat in any School as per the preference of choices filled by him/her and merit, he/she has to complete admission formalities (Medical (if not previously shortlisted) cum Physical Verification of documents) within the prescribed time (**As per the timeline on the portal**). Failing to do so, the candidate will not be able to participate in any further round of counselling or claim admission in any School based on the merit of the AISSEE-2026. The candidate accepting the allotted school needs to follow the steps as given below: -

40.1 **STEP-1: REPORTING AT MEDICAL CENTRE**. After seat acceptance, candidates will have to report at the Medical Examination Centre (if not shortlisted for medicals previously) as per the Slot allotted by the admitting school. It is the parent's responsibility to get the medical done of their son/daughter. However, the school will provide help to the candidates in coordinating with Medical Authorities, in case of any problem faced by the parents

40.2 **STEP-2: PHYSICAL VERIFICATION BY ALLOTTED SCHOOL**. After the medical fitness report, candidates will have to report at the admitting school, and produce all required documents to the admitting school. The admission will be cancelled, if the candidate fails to meet the requirements as per the prevailing norms. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the candidate to keep the valid certificate or document ready. All the certificates/documents will be verified at the time of Physical reporting at the admitting school.

40.3 **STEP-3: PAYMENT OF FEE**. After completing the above two steps or any other admission formalities of the admitting school, pay the fees of the school and get the admission confirmed.

After completion of all formalities, Principal of the schools is requested to update the status of the candidates by clicking on 'ADMIT' tab.

It is the candidate's responsibility to plan their travel such that the Medical cum physical verification of documents is completed by the last day of the counselling round in which they are allocated a seat (if any) [As per the timeline on the portal]. No exceptions shall be made in this regard.

41. **Candidates on 'HOLD'**. The candidates may face the following types of situations: -

41.1 **Candidates Declared Medically Unfit**. The decision of the Medical Board will be final except where a representation has been made to the Principal. The Principal will examine the appeal himself and decide with reference to the evidence produced before him if the case calls for merit. A case in which competent medical opinion is produced to counter the finding of the previous Medical Board, will normally merit a review. Such cases will be put on 'HOLD' by the Principal.

41.1.1 Subsequently, the Principal may coordinate with the medical authorities and arrange a Review Medical Board for the re-examination of the candidate. If the Review Medical Board finds him fit for admission, the Principal will **'ADMIT'** the candidate on the portal and admit him to the school if his rejection was only on account of lack of medical fitness after Physical Verification and payment of fees.

41.1.2 The school may charge a fee of **Rs.100/- (Rs.50/- from SC/ST candidates)** for holding a Review Medical Board. However, the candidate will be required to appear before the **Review Medical Board at the designated place** at his own expense. In the case of an **UNFIT** report, the Principal will click the **'REJECT'** button on the Portal.

41.2 **Discrepancies in the documents.** In case of any discrepancies in the documents during Physical Verification, query(ies) (if required) raised by the allotted school must be responded by the candidate within the last date/time specified for the given round [as per the timeline on the portal]. Additional query(ies) may be raised by the school in case discrepancy(ies) still persist(s).

41.2.1 In such cases, the candidate must respond to the additional query(ies) within the last date/time specified for the given round [as per the timeline on the portal]. The allocated seat will be confirmed or cancelled based on the validity of the document(s) produced in response to the query(ies) and the candidate meeting the eligibility criteria.

41.2.2 Failure to reply to the query(ies) raised would lead to seat cancellation and will be considered as a rejection of the offer. **Such cases can also be put on 'HOLD' by the Principal at their discretion owing to the veracity of the case.** In all HOLD cases, the seat of the school will be blocked and will not be released till the time school **ADMIT /REJECT** the candidate's status on the Portal.

42. It is the parent's/candidate's responsibility to plan their travel such that the Review Medicals (if not shortlisted for medicals earlier) cum physical verification of the documents is completed by the last day of the e-counselling round in which they are allocated a seat (if any) [as per Timeline]. No exceptions shall be made in this regard.

43. The Parents are also advised to keep adequate funds ready at the time of registration and choice filling for payment of the Fees, in case of allotment of school to avoid last-minute hassles. Non-payment of the fee within the Timelines subject to the fitness of Medical standards (including Review Medicals) cum physical verification, is one of the ways to reject the offered/allocated seat in school and will be treated as a rejection. In such a situation, the school may reject the candidate with reasons and the candidate will no longer be able to participate in the seat allocation process in the subsequent rounds.

44. Candidates who do not take any action to the allocated seat **CANNOT** participate for the same allotted seat/school further any more in Seat Allocation for the ensuing academic year 2026-27.

CATEGORY/GENDER/DOMICILE DISCREPANCIES IN THE DOCUMENT

45. **Gender discrepancies.** If a female candidate wrongly declares their gender as male and is allotted a seat in a school where female candidates are restricted, the allotted seat will be cancelled. Similarly, if a male candidate wrongly declares the gender as female and is allotted a Female-Only seat, the allotted seat will be cancelled. Such candidates would not be considered for any further seat allocation in AISSAC-2026.

46. **Domicile discrepancies**. The candidate shall not be considered for seat allocation in the presently allotted school or in subsequent rounds against remaining vacancies, as adequate opportunity for correction of particulars was provided through the public notice at '**Appendix E**'.

47. **Category discrepancies**. For candidates who have wrongly declared their category and where the same is detected at a later stage during Physical Verification, the candidature shall be treated as cancelled for seat allocation in the presently allotted school as well as in subsequent rounds against remaining vacancies, as adequate opportunity for correction of particulars was provided through the public notice at '**Appendix E**'.

48. **Principals of schools shall ensure strict compliance in all discrepancy cases and adhere to the admission guidelines issued on the subject.**

49. Delays or disruptions in service due to the breakdown of AISSAC computer servers shall be rectified as early as possible and notified on the web portal. The decisions of AISSAC/SSS in this regard shall be final and binding.

50. **Grievances Redressal/helpdesk**: -

50.1 In case of any query/grievance you may contact any of the Sainik Schools or New Sainik Schools as per the details placed at **Appendix A & B**.

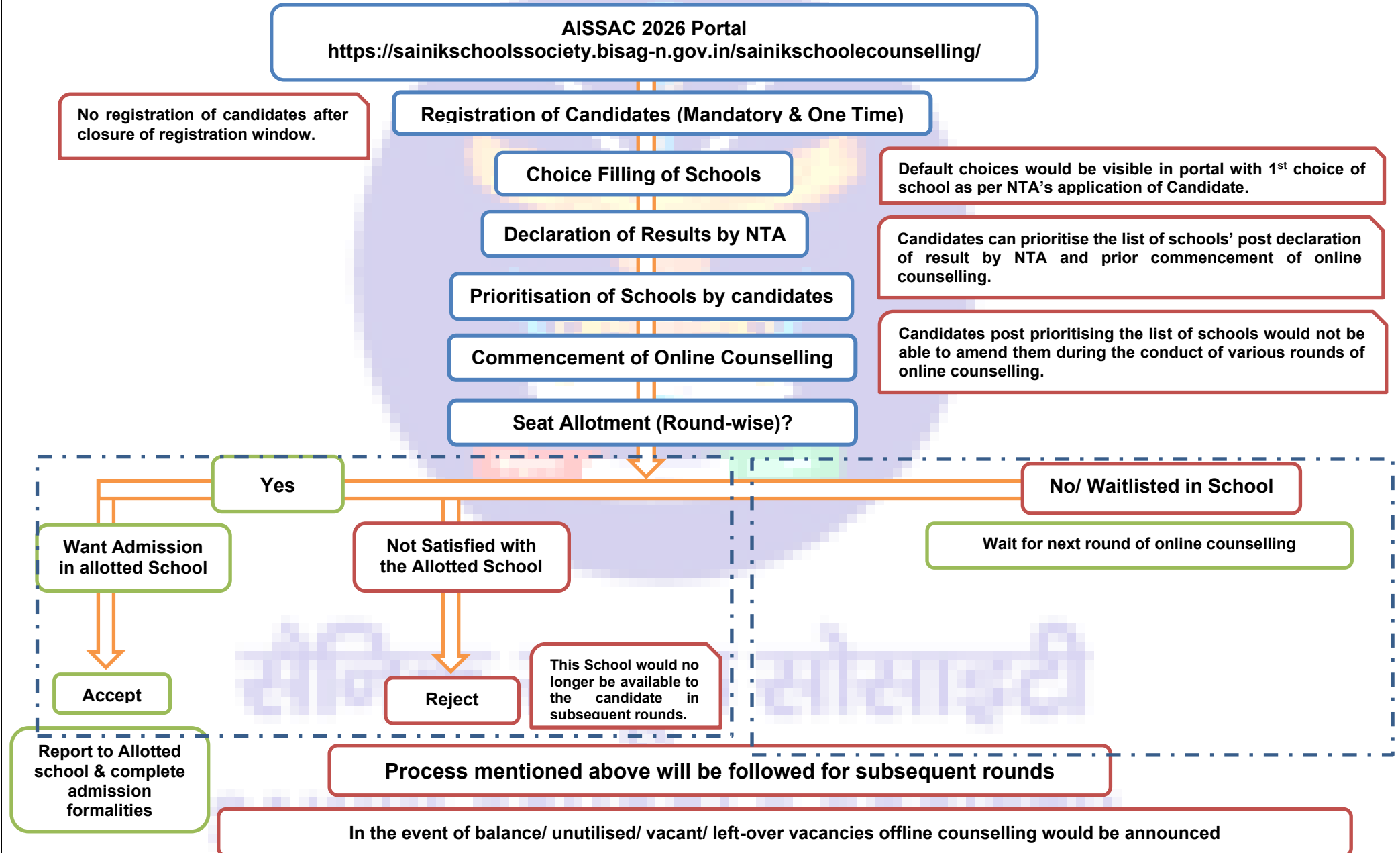
FLOW CHART OF AISSAC COUNSELLING - 2026

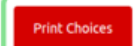
