Sub: Amendment of Rule 6.33 (b) regarding Technical Resignation

It has been decided with the approval of Chairman, Board of Governors to amend rule 6.33(b) of Sainik Schools Rules and Regulations as under:

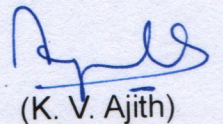
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If the application for employment in other organizations has been forwarded through proper channel and the employee resigns before accepting the job, such resignation will be treated as technical resignation only if he is taking up the job with the Govt. of India, a State Govt. the Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti or the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. In all other cases of resignations, the employee will not be entitled to pension or other retirement benefits.

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If the application for employment in other organizations has been forwarded through proper channel and the employee resigns before accepting the job, such resignation will be treated as technical resignation if he or she is taking up the job with the Govt. of India, State Govt., the Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti or the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. Further, if an employee resigns from his/her present post to take up another appointment within the same Sainik School or in any other Sainik School, provided the application was forwarded through proper channel with NOC from current Sainik School, such resignation shall also be treated as Technical Resignation. In all other cases of resignations, the employee will not be entitled to pension or other retirement benefits.

2. The application of this rule will be prospective in nature and will not be applicable on cases where an employee has already submitted his/her resignation.
